LOCAL LAW # 2 OF THE TOWN OF COLUMBIA

A LOCAL LAW TO REPEAL LOCAL LAW # 1 OF 1984, AND PROVIDING THAT THE TOWN WILL ADMINISTER AND ENFORCE THE UNIFORM FIRE PREVENTION AND BUILDING CODE.

BE IT ENACTED, by the Town Board of the Town of Columbia, New York as follows:

WHEREAS, the Town of Columbia, Herkimer County, New York heretofore adopted Local Law # 1 of 1984 on June 30, 1984, whereby it opted out of the responsibility for the administration and enforcement of the Uniform Fire and Building Code, in accordance with the provisions of §381 (2) of the Executive Law of the State of New York, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Columbia has determined to exercise its powers pursuant to §381 of the Executive Law of the State of New York and repeal said Local Law # 1 of 1984, and henceforth to administer and enforce the Uniform Fire Prevention and Building Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Columbia as follows:

§ 1. That the Town of Columbia, Herkimer County, New York shall, effective January 1, 1991 enforce and administer the New York State Uniform Fire Prevention and Building Code pursuant to the authority vested in the Town by § 381 of the Executive Law of the State of New York, and

§ 2. Local Law # 1, of 1984 of the Town of Columbia, Herkimer County, New York is hereby repealed.

§ 3. This Local Law shall become effective January 1, 1991, and upon filing with the Secretary of State.

§ 4. That the Town Clerk of the town of Columbia, Herkimer County, New York, is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this Local Law in the principal office of the State Building Code Council, and in the office of the Town Clerk.

§ 5. That a copy of a Notice of Adoption of this Local Law shall be published in the Herkimer Evening Telegram, the Official Town Newspaper following the adoption of this Local Law.
